Hey Readers!!

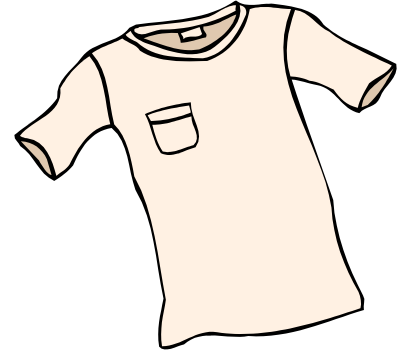
